Whereas the design of the conservatory, choice of colours and glazing options is completely up to you to decide – we do insist on incorporating the following into our work – on every single installation:

- **1. Planning Permission / Building Regulations:** We undertake a thorough survey of your installation to ensure we have considered all of the necessary approvals you may require. Ultimately it is the homeowner's responsibility to ensure that all necessary approvals have been obtained but we do consider this to be an important element of our design & advice process.
- **2. Safety glazing:** Although most conservatories do not require Building Regulation approval we do insist on incorporating some Building Regulation rules into our conservatories nonetheless. A good example of this is our insistence on using safety glazing in low level areas of glazed windows & always in doors.
- **3. Electrical safety:** All our electrical work within a conservatory installation is carried out by NICEIC approved contractors. As part of your guarantee paperwork you will receive a NICEIC small works certificate which demonstrates compliance to current electrical safety standards.


Traditional Edwardian and Georgian

Our Edwardian conservatories combine modern, stylish, design with the elegant and traditional character of the Edwardian era. Usually, rectangular in shape the Edwardian allows you to create maximum floor space, which combined with the three sided glass and high pitched roof creates a light and airy living space.

Similar to the Edwardian, the Georgian conservatory is characterised by light and space, but with more subdued lines than the ornate Victorian style. Featuring a flat front and a square or rectangular shape the Georgian typically has a high, sloping roof style that gives a spectacular vaulted effect flooding your conservatory with light, making it a bright, airy and uplifting room.



Edwardian & Georgian conservatories maximise on the useable inside space thanks to their square edges and 90 degree corners.



KEY POINT

The majority of conservatories built in the UK are Edwardian or Georgian in shape. Their popularity is in part due to their user-friendliness.






Traditional Victorian

The elegance of the Victorian conservatory adds a touch of style to any home, from new build to period property. The soft edges of Victorian conservatories are designed to match and compliment traditional 3, 5 or even 6 sided bay windows.

Its bay-curved front provides excellent views of your garden and together with a steeply pitched roof creates maximum light. The elegant roof creating and ornate finials provide the finishing touch.



KEY POINT

Victorian conservatories are often specified in instances where it is important to avoid obstructing a neighbour's view.






Traditional Gable Front

Sharing many characteristics with the Edwardian, Gable Front conservatories feature a traditional apex pitched roof combined with a striking front elevation, being fully glazed right up to the apex.

Gable Front conservatories give the maximum amount of space to plan a delightful interior. The height of the conservatory lends the room a feeling of space while the stunning sunburst design to the Gable Front adds style and maximises light.



KEY POINT

The main feature why people love Gable Fronted conservatories is the feeling of space inside the room. The extra height gained feels very impressive.





Traditional Lean to Conservatory



This is because of the variable pitch of the roof, allowing the conservatory to slot in just about anywhere and create the perfect living space.

When coupled with bi-folding doors a Liv-In room also creates a seamless link between your home and your garden.



KEY POINT

In most cases, you can build your Liv-In room all the way across the back of your property without Planning Permission regardless of the type of property.





Orangery / Loggia

Combining the best of British building excellence with Italian style and inspiration, Loggia is a unique building concept that creates stunning extensions through revolutionary engineering, seamlessly blending your extension and home. By replacing masonry piers, with the super insulated Loggia columns which retain 5 times more heat than insulated brick walls, for the first time, it is even easier now to remove internal doors leading to your new Loggia and still remain compliant with Building Regulations.








Solid Roof 380 Tile

The main benefit of a 380 tiled roof is that it is super insulated so it can retain warmth inside your conservatory like no other type of roof system. But a 380 roof also offers great privacy from neighbouring homes as well as blocking out the glare from the sun. For those who want 'the best of both worlds' we can easily add glazed sections into the roof too so that your internal space can still be flooded with natural light. There are 3 tile colour choices available so you can match your 380 roof to your main home roof – to create a seamless overall effect.











Solid Roof Liv-In Roof

The Liv-In roof is a brand new solution which uses tried & trusted technology in a completely new way. The Liv-In roof can be used to re-vamp an existing conservatory which may be too hot to use in summer or too cold to use in winter. It can also be used as part of a completely new conservatory installation. Its excellent heat retaining properties ensure that this solid roof not only looks fantastic but also helps to create an extremely comfortable environment in which you can live all year round.

In most cases, you can build your solid roof conservatory all the way across the back of your property without Planning Permission regardless of the type of property.





KEY POINT


If your home is semi-detached or terraced your new solid roof conservatory can extend into your garden by 3m without the need for Planning Permission approval. For detached properties you can stretch this dimension to 4m!





P-Shape Conservatory

A Finesse P-Shaped conservatory allows you to combine different styles and is ideal if you have a large space to work with, an Edwardian section combined with an ornate Victorian rounded section works harmoniously. The rounded space that the P shape provides can become a child's play area or a hobby area, whilst you still have the longer section for an elegant dining room or relaxing space. This use of 'zones' will provide many options and means your conservatory will be constantly flexible and adaptable over time.



KEY POINT

Customers love P-shaped conservatories because they offer an easy way to separate the space inside into two distinct areas.

Built to last

Base Cross Section


We have continually developed our conservatory base design over 3 decades and we do believe that our conservatory bases are amongst the most substantial & robust that you will find anywhere in the UK.

To us, the base is perhaps the most important of all the elements of a conservatory. If the base is solid and correctly specified it forms the bedrock upon which all of the rest of the conservatory depends. From the extra deep, mass filled footings to the steel reinforced concrete pad section and beyond, our bases are designed to withstand the test of time like no other.



All our uPVC window and door frames are fully reinforced with steel and all our corner posts are fully reinforced with a structural aluminium system. This is not only important from a security point of view but absolutely crucial in terms of structural stability. The steel & aluminium inside our uPVC serves to bolster the weight load capacity of our framework. The reinforcing is crucial to safely transfer extremely heavy loads from the roof – through the framework and down into the base.









Full Aluminium Structure

All our conservatory roof systems are constructed from aluminium. They are extremely strong and designed to safely carry the weight of the glass or other glazing material and transfer weight loads down into the frame structure. We finish the roof with uPVC top and bottom caps so that they are visually attractive – but under the uPVC it is the aluminium beams and rafters that are doing all the hard, important work!



Your **Postcode** Matters

All our conservatories are designed with your specific postcode in mind. The expected windspeed and snow load demands in your exact postcode location are loaded into the equation so that your roof is specified to exceed the worst extremes of weather conditions that our climate could throw at your conservatory.



BBA Approved


Every Finesse roof has BBA approval as standard – meaning that it is certified to exceed the demands that it will face when installed in your home. The British Board of Agrément is a leading UK notified body, providing approval, certification and test services to construction industry suppliers who manufacture products and systems. The organisation is recognised as a worldwide authority on approved products in the construction industry.



The Iceberg Effect

Regardless of the shape of your conservatory it is likely that up to 2/3 of the cost of the overall conservatory build is actually spent on the base building work – most of which is underground and will never be seen. Whilst this may come as a surprise, we believe that this is absolutely the right way to build a conservatory.

We will never ever compromise on the quality of our base construction or cut corners to reduce costs here. If the base isn't fit for purpose the whole stability of the building is compromised.





A Room You Can Use All Year Round

A Conservatory by Finesse Windows can transform your home's living space, creating an extra room that can have many uses Whether it's a relaxing family room, a dining room to entertain close friends or a comfortable lounge area, the light and airy space that a traditional glass roof conservatory provides is a wonderful extension to any home.


We believe it is essential that your new conservatory is comfortable for you to use all year round, despite the UK's erratic climate; our team of Design Experts are here to guide and advise.

Conservatories which are south facing need to take into account the direct sunlight they receive in the summer, whilst north facing sites need to consider heating options for the colder months of the year. We advise on overshadowing from trees and neighbouring buildings, and even the severity of wind and snow in your area

When designing your conservatory, our team will advise you on choosing the right specification of glass, which is crucial for creating that comforting environment. For all year round use a glazing material that deflects the heat in the summer yet retains the warmth in the winter

Roof Glazing Specification:

The choice of glazing material in your roof can make or break the useability of your conservatory.





- 1. Reduce Glare
- 2. Reduce Heat Transmittance
- 3. Self Clean
- 4. Bounce Heat Back in from Radiators

Solar Control: If your room is South facing it is important to consider using a glass that can reduce glare from the sun and also block out much of the sun's heat and harmful rays.

Heat Retention: If your conservatory faces North, it is important to use a glass that retains much of the expensive heat you generate internally. This is achieved by filling the glazed unit cavity with argon gas and using special coatings on the glass to bounce radiated heat back inside the room.

As standard: All our conservatories feature an insulated glazing 'top cap' which fits above each aluminium roof bar. This top cap design helps to keep more heat inside your conservatory.

Self Clean: What could be better than not having to worry about cleaning your new roof? Ask our designers about our choices of glazing that eradicate the need to get up on the roof and clean.




Built with your comfort in mind


A-Rated windows: The sides of your conservatory will be constructed from our A-rated 'Elegance' range of windows. The sides of your conservatory are just as important as the roof in terms of their responsibility to help to control the temperature inside your room. By using our A-rated windows we ensure that as much heat as possible is retained inside. If we are installing doors into your conservatory – the glass we install in them will be the same specification as the glass in our A-rated windows.

Underfloor heating: We can take care of the installation of underfloor heating as part of our work. This is an excellent way to introduce a non-intrusive heat source into the room.

Base Insulation: As standard all our conservatories incorporate 50mm of insulation into the base – this helps to stop cold transfer from the ground rising up into your floor.

Wall Insulation: As standard all our conservatory wall sections feature 50mm of insulation meaning that the room retains more warmth inside and combats cold transfer from outside.





Column radiators: these column radiators are a great option to add heat into your new room – they are ultrastylish and fit neatly into corners – ask our designers about incorporating them into your design.





Security - built in

There is much more to the perfect conservatory window than simply how it looks in your home. All of our conservatory windows and doors feature Police approved "Secure By Design" locking technology so you'll have the complete peace of mind that your home and belongings are safe from intruders.





FULL STEEL REINFORCING

All our conservatories are fully reinforced with steel, with every screw being firmly anchored into it.



SHOOTBOLT LOCKING SYSTEM

The Finesse Windows shootbolt locking mechanism ensures that the opening windows are secured at their most vulnerable points on the window.



INTERNAL GLAZING

The glass or paneled units in all conservatories manufactured by Finesse Windows are all fixed into position using internal glazing beads. This crucial detail makes it impossible to de-glaze the unit from the outside – a burglars favourite method of entry.



HIGH SECURITY CAMS

Each sash has a series of security cams with mushroom heads. They also assist in compressing the double sealed gaskets forming an air tight seal they engage into high security keeps running along the opening side of the sash which drastically increases the windows security.



KEY LOCKING HANDLES

Finesse Windows handles can be key locked to give you further protection and peace of mind. Key locking handles can often be a requirement of your home insurance policy.



HIGH SECURITY SASH CLAWS

To provide maximum security at the locking handle area of an opening sash we install 2 high security claws that secure themselves to the fully reinforced frame, thus ensuring that a potential intruder will not be able to force the conservatory window open.



HIGH SECURITY HINGES

All hinges used on our conservatories are fitted to high security specification. They add to the security of the window by locking the sash into position as it locates into the frame.




HIGH SECURITY KEEPS

Our zinc cast keeps are extremely robust and secure the shootbolts into our fully reinforced frames.



All our doors feature an exceptionally secure locking cylinder.

Anti-snap Anti-drill Bump-resistant



HINGE PROTECTORS

We fit these to all sashes to further protect against crowbar attack. The hinge protectors clamp together under attack, making it almost impossible to force the sash open.

At Finesse, we know that making the right choice for your Conservatory is an important decision, that's why at every step in the process we work with you to ensure all your needs are met.

On initial site survey, one of our Design Experts will measure and document your requirement, and advise you of the best solution.

We then invite you into our showroom, where we let you get a real hands on feel for the options with our full size example conservatories and orangeries.

We believe it is important you understand why every element of a Finesse conservatory makes them the best on the market. Our Design Expert, using our bespoke design tool, works with you to get you the Conservatory that you desire; from colour, through to window design, door options, underfloor heating, lighting, even down to the style and colour of the handles.

















All the way through the process, from enquiry to completed installation, our team are aways available. We manage the process of obtaining any required planning permission, and project manage any requirements for plastering or electrics. So at the end, you are left with a new room which exceeds your expectations.







The Regulations

There is a distinct difference between Building Regulations, Planning Permission and Conservation area approval. Sometimes you require none of these, sometimes you will need all or any combination of the three. Whatever the situation we are here to advise and take the stress out of the process for you. As a brief overview, the regulations state*:

Building Regulations:

You do not need to gain Building Regulation approval for your 'conservatory' as long as your building complies with the following:

- It is separated from the main home with quality external doors e.g. patio door / French door
- It's footprint is less than 30m²
- It has 50% or more glazing in the sides
- It has 30% or more glass in the roof
- It has a heating source that can be isolated from the rest of the main home

If your building does require Building Regulation approval we can take care of this process for you as part of our contract – so you don't have to worry about it – from initial inspections, SAP reports – right through to final approval sign off.

Planning Permission:

You do not need to gain Planning Permission for your 'conservatory' as long as your building complies with the following:


- The projection is 3m or less (for a terraced or semidetached) or 4m or less (for a detached property)
- If the conservatory is at the side of your home it should not be wider than half of the original home width
- When added to the area of other outhouses or extensions the total area covered does not exceed 50% of the total land around your home
- Your home is not at the end of a road

If your building does require Planning Permission, we can take care of this process for you as part of our contract – this includes the drawing of detailed plans for submission to the local council and all necessary approval paperwork – right through to completion.

Conservation area:

Being located near the historic Bournville Village Trust conservation area means we have decades of experience in handling applications for making home improvements in conservation areas. Preserving the style and integrity of historically important buildings and areas is really important to us and we enjoy taking the time to get it just right. We will take care of the whole process from start to finish keeping you fully informed along the way.

*this is not a definitive list – please speak to your local council planning authority for a full list of considerations that may be applicable to your home. The homeowner is ultimately responsible to ensure that all relevant approvals are gained.






